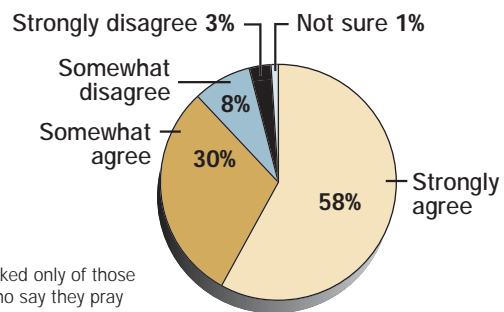




# How America Prays

To what extent do you agree or disagree that prayer can have a positive impact on national or world events?\*

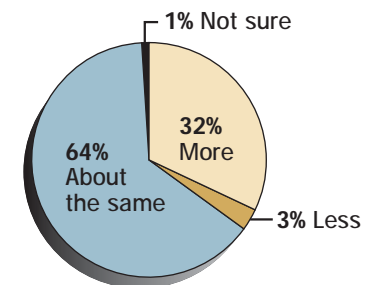

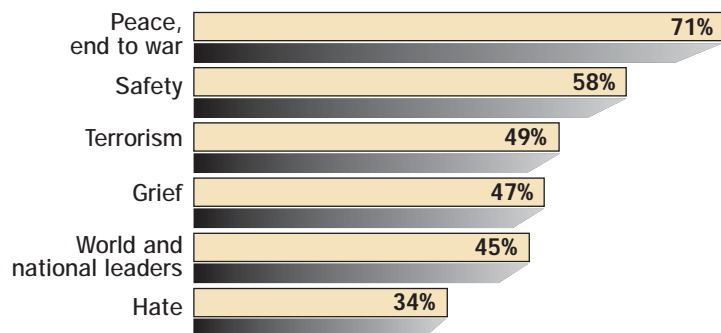
Would you say you pray to (select all that apply):



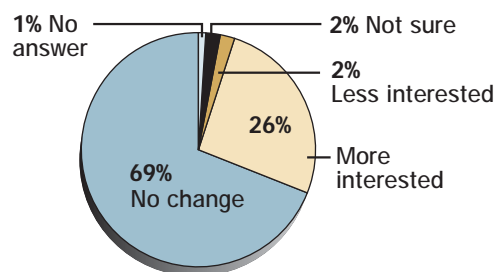
Would you say you are praying more, less, or about the same as before Sept. 11, 2001?



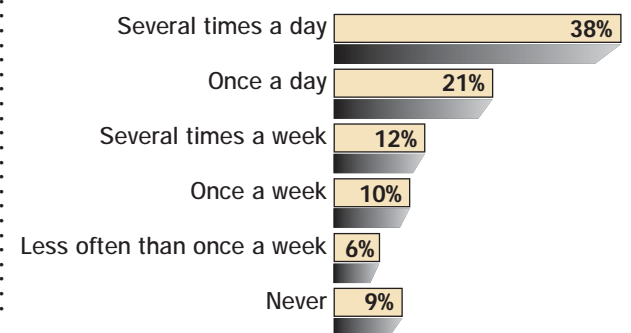
Which of the following subjects have you prayed about in the past year? Select all that apply.
