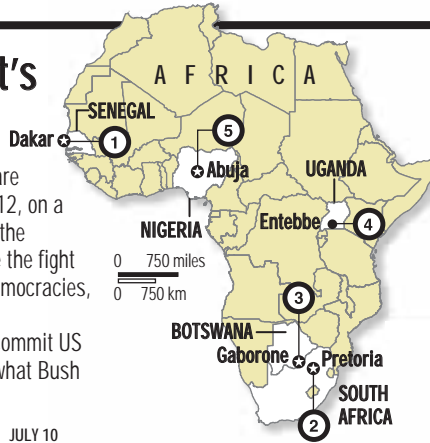


## The president's trip to Africa

President and Mrs. Bush are traveling to Africa, July 7-12, on a five-country tour. High on the president's priority list are the fight against AIDS, emerging democracies, military dictatorships, and international pressure to commit US troops to Liberia. Here is what Bush will do at key stops:



JULY 8

### ① Dakar, Senegal

► Meet with President Abdoulaye Wade and later tour Goree Island, the infamous former slave port.

JULY 8-9

### ② Pretoria, South Africa

► Lunch with President Thabo Mbeki and dinner with South African and US business executives.

JULY 10

### ③ Gaborone, Botswana

► Lunch with President Festus Mogae; later tour the newly dedicated Southern Africa Global Competitiveness Hub, a US-backed trading center for African exports; and the Mokolodi Nature Reserve.

JULY 11

### ④ Entebbe, Uganda

► Meet with President Yoweri Museveni; later

tour the Taso AIDS clinic and patient-support center.

JULY 12

### ⑤ Abuja, Nigeria

► Meet with President Olusegun Obasanjo and deliver remarks to the African-American biannual summit.
