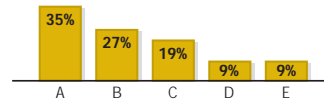
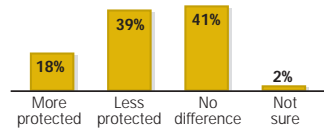

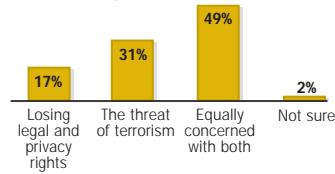
Grade President Bush's performance so far in fighting terrorism:



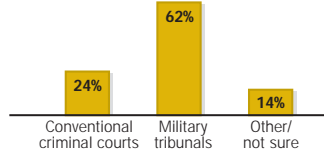
Do you believe your privacy is more protected, less protected, or not significantly changed since Sept. 11?



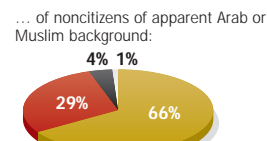
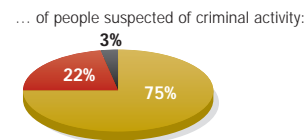
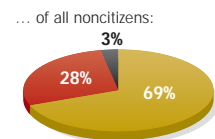
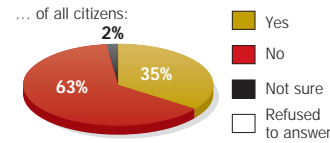
Between the threat of terrorism and the idea of losing legal and privacy rights, what worries you more?
